OPINION

Day, Chairman:

The report in these cases was issued on February 28, 1985. That report contained conclusions of law and recommendations. An extended time for exceptions has passed. Only one party with any semblance of standing has timely excepted. Those exceptions lack a certificate of service and, therefore, must be dismissed.¹ This factual state leaves the report and recommendations without exception.²

A careful examination of the report and recommendations and the supporting evidence indicates that the units proposed are both rational and in accordance with law. The recommended units are approved - also approved in the substance of recommendations 2 through 4 with slight additions to provide practical procedures necessary for the determination of representation in the approved units.

The cases are now in a stance which makes the argument opportunities set for April 11 and 12, 1985 improvident. Therefore, the scheduled dates for oral arguments are cancelled.³

²Service after the exception would be untimely and therefore totally flawed.


³The propriety of cancellation is evident from the fact that only one party filed written exceptions and that one improperly.

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
The several conclusions reached in this opinion are reflected in the accompanying order.
