In the above-entitled negotiations, the parties hereto agree as follows:


1. the current collective bargaining agreement between them shall remain in full force and effect until a successor agreement is reached or implemented, whether as a result of ratification of a tentative agreement or through the use of statutory dispute resolution proceedings at O.R.C. §4117;
2. the date for the fact finder to issue his/her report is extended to December 16, 2013; *NOTE ATT*
3. the provisions of 4117.14 (G) (11) will be waived in regard to all matters of compensation or with cost implications which may be awarded by a conciliator in accordance with Chapter 4117 O.R.C. and agree that the conciliator may award wage increases or other matters with cost implications to be retroactive to January 1, 2013.
