**First Amendment to the
Collective Bargaining Agreement (Contract No. 6640)**

by and between

Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc.

And

City of Cuyahoga Falls

This First Amendment to the collective bargaining agreement (Contract No. 6640) by and between the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. ("FOP"), representing dispatchers, is entered into as of this 7th day of November, 2011, ("City"), pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 47-211, passed 11/01, 2011,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 125-2010 the City and FOP, on February 28, 2011, entered into the collective bargaining agreement now known as City Contract No. 6640 (the "Contract"), and

WHEREAS, it is in the mutual best interests of the City and FOP to amend the Contract, and the parties desire to do so,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the City and FOP hereby agree as follows:

1. Article 28 of Contract No. 6640 is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

Article 28. Wages

Section 1.

All steps of the bargaining unit's wage schedule have been increased by one half of one percent (.5%) to account for the additional knowledge required of Dispatchers who are now providing service to three distinct municipalities (retroactive to July 1, 2008).

Effective January 1, 2011 all bargaining unit members in all steps shall receive a 0.0% wage increase. Effective October 1, 2011 all bargaining unit members in all steps shall receive a 2.25% wage increase. Effective January 1, 2012 and January 1, 2013, all bargaining unit members in all steps shall receive a 0.0% wage increase.

Said adjustments and increases are reflected in the following schedule.

Article 36. Term of Agreement

This Agreement shall be in effect from January 1, 2011 to December 31, 2013. To initiate negotiations for a successor agreement, either party shall give written notice to the other at least ninety (90) days prior to December 31, 2013.



13 WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority of Ord. No. 125-2010, the Mayor entered into a collec-
14 tive bargaining agreement (Contract No. 6640) with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor
15 Council, Inc. ("FOP"), representing dispatchers, and

17 WHEREAS, the Mayor and his representatives and the FOP have bargained collectively and in
18 good faith and said bargaining has resulted in a tentative agreement on an amendment to Con-
19 tract No. 6640, and

21 WHEREAS, on or about October 24, 2011, the membership of FOP ratified said amendment;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
24 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:



26 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into an amendment of Contract No. 6640
27 with the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. ("FOP"), representing dispatchers,
28 substantially in the form of agreement placed on file with the Clerk of Council in Council File No.



31 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
32 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordi-
33 nances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
34 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

36 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
37 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
38 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
39 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
40 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

42 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
44 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
45 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
46 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
47 period allowed by law.
