

AMENDMENT
TO THE
COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
THE CITY OF TRENTON
AND
THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION
(DISPATCHERS)
EFFECTIVE
JANUARY 1, 2011 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013

The City of Trenton and OPBA have met pursuant to the wage reopener for 2013 for the bargaining unit of Dispatchers and agree that the following language shall replace and supersede the language in Article 11, Wages and Exhibit A.

ARTICLE 11

WAGES

11.1 Bargaining unit employees shall be paid in accordance with Exhibit A, attached hereto. For 2011, there shall be a wage freeze. Bargaining unit employees will receive a 1% increase effective January 1, 2012 and a 1% increase effective July 1, 2012. Bargaining unit employees will receive a 2% increase effective January 6, 2013.

11.2 For any employee hired prior to June 1, 2004, merit reviews shall be completed semi-annually in June and December. Any members of this bargaining unit hired on or after June 1, 2004, shall receive an annual merit review on their anniversary hire date in accordance with Section 250.06 of the "Codified Ordinances of Trenton, Ohio."
