

**AMENDMENT TO THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS
BETWEEN THE CITY OF BARBERTON AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S
BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (SERGEANTS AND LIEUTENANTS) (POLICE
OFFICERS) AND (DISPATCHER/JAILERS) BARGAINING UNITS**

Whereas, pursuant to the parties' 2011 to 2013 Collective Bargaining Agreements a "wage reopener" was timely initiated by the OPBA;


Whereas, as a result of reaching impasse pursuant to the wage reopener negotiations, the parties mutually agreed to go to fact finding as a means of resolution of the matter;

Whereas a recommendation was provided to the parties by the Fact finder and both parties agreed to adopt the findings of the fact finder as follows:

The aforementioned bargaining units will receive a 2% increase in their wages effective January 1, 2013. Additionally, a one time lump sum payment of \$400.00 with proper withholding of all taxes and deductions will be provided to each of the aforementioned bargaining unit employees in a separate direct deposit;

Now therefore, in consideration of the above, the 2013 wage scale for the affected bargaining unit contracts shall be increased by 2% and is reflected in the attached Appendix hereto.




