THE FOP/OHIO LABOR COUNCIL, Inc.



The above parties conducted negotiations on the re-opener which resulted in a tentative agreement. Both parties has ratified the tentative agreement.




Now, therefore, the pay range of all Correction Officers and Sergeants shall be increased by 3% effective October 1, 2013.
