RESOLUTION NUMBER 2014-4 RATIFYING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE ASHTABULA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES AND THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES (AFSCME) LOCAL 14

The Board of County Commissioners of Ashtabula County, Ohio, met on the 9th day of January, 2014, in regular session at the offices of said Board in the Old Courthouse Building, 2nd Floor, Jefferson, Ohio, with the following members present: Daniel R. Claypool, Peggy A. Carlo, Joseph A. Moroski.

WHEREAS, The Ashtabula County Commissioners have been negotiating with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Local 14; for representation of certain employees of the Ashtabula County Department of Job and Family Services in collective bargaining procedures; and

WHEREAS, On December 18, 2013 a union vote was taken for the ratification of a wage-reopener agreement for January 1, 2012 – December 31, 2014, said agreement being ratified by a majority vote of the union membership; and

WHEREAS, all bargaining unit employees who are in active payroll status shall receive a \$.50 (fifty cents) per hour wage increase effective the first (1st) full pay period in January, 2014. The parties agree to discuss classification rates for jobs within the bargaining unit during the next set of negotiations for a full contract in the fall of 2014; and

WHEREAS, The recommendation of Patrick Arcaro, Director of the Ashtabula County Department of Job and Family Services, is that the Board ratify the collective bargaining agreement; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of Commissioners of Ashtabula County, Ohio, that the agreement between American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Local 14 and the Ashtabula County Department of Job and Family Services for union representation for certain of the Department of Job & Family Services employees be and the same is hereby ratified.
