Article 29
Letter C

Whenever schools are closed due to a calamity, all 260 day employees will work. (Memorandum of Understanding, dated November 11, 2012.) Other employees that may be necessary for the orderly continuation of the District, as determined by the Superintendent or designee may also be called to work. Employees performing work on calamity days receive time and a half (1½) for all hours actually worked (an employee who normally earns \$10 per hour will earn \$15 per hour for time worked on a calamity day). **NECESSARY PAPERWORK MUST BE TURNED IN WITHIN (5) WORK DAYS AFTER THE CALAMITY DAY OCCURED.**


