June 3, 2013

It is hereby mutually agreed between the Washington Local Schools administration and TAWLS, that district-wide special education units which serve students from multiple buildings may periodically need to be moved to different buildings within the district due to available classroom space, transportation issues or other district considerations.

When an existing district-wide special education unit is relocated to a different building, the teacher currently assigned to that unit shall have first choice to move with the unit, regardless of seniority.

If the teacher chooses not to relocate, the vacant position shall be filled through the normal reassignment and transfer process as specified in the TAWLS Master Agreement.
