

COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT

ADDENDUM NUMBER ONE

This Addendum Number One made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2015 and effective July 1, 2014, by and between the Board of Mahoning County Commissioners, the Mahoning County Sheriff, Jerry Greene (collectively "Employer") and the Fraternal Order of Police, Ohio Labor Council, Inc. ("FOP") representing the Blue Unit of the Mahoning County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") effective July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016.

WHEREAS, the above referenced CBA contained a reopener clause on certain articles.

WHEREAS, the parties engaged in negotiations on certain contractual provisions subject to reopener under the original CBA in 2014.

WHEREAS, the parties resolved certain contractual provisions and reached impasse on others.

WHEREAS, the parties engaged in the conciliation process before Conciliator Harry Graham on the issues at impasse.

WHEREAS, Conciliator Graham issued a decision on December 16, 2014.

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to supplement the original CBA with the provisions that were reopened and resolved.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

1. Article 19 Overtime, Sections 19.01 and 19.02 shall be amended to read as follows:

**Section 19.01** For all overtime hours, except those accrued on Holidays, overtime shall be paid at the rate of one and one-half (1½) times a rate determined by dividing the employee's base pay by 2,080 hours. All bargaining unit employees shall be compensated at such rate for all hours worked over in a workday or, in excess of hours in any workweek. At the employee's option, the employee may be compensated with compensatory time. Compensatory time will be accumulated at employee's request. There will be no limit/cap on the number of compensatory hours that may be accumulated by an employee.

Section 19.02 For all overtime hours accrued on Holidays worked under Article 20, overtime shall be paid at the rate of two and one-half ( $2^{1/2}$ ) times a rate determined by dividing the employee's base pay by 2,080 hours. All bargaining unit employees shall be compensated at such rate for all hours over on a Holiday workday. At the employee's option, the employee may be compensated with compensatory time. Compensatory time will be accumulated at employee's request. There will be no limit/cap on the number of compensatory hours that may be accumulated by an employee.

2. **Article 20** Holidays, Section 20.02 shall be amended to read as follows:

Section 20.02 Any bargaining unit employee who is required to work on any of the holidays set forth in Article 20, Section 20.01 hereof shall receive an hourly rate of pay which is  $2\frac{1}{2}$  times the employee's regular hourly rate of pay for all hours worked on said holiday. Any employee who earns overtime while working on any Holiday referenced in Section 20.01 above shall be paid in accordance with Section 19.02 only.

3. **Article 23**, Longevity shall be deleted and removed from the contract effective July 1, 2014. In its place, each member, upon the completion of the required length of continuous full-time service as an employee of the Mahoning County Sheriff's Office, shall have the following amounts of stipend added to their hourly rate of pay:

Upon the completion of year 12 -	\$0.75 per hour
Upon the completion of year 15 -	\$1.03 per hour
Upon the completion of year 18 -	\$1.21 per hour
Upon the completion of year 21 -	\$1.66 per hour
Upon the completion of year 24 -	\$1.88 per hour
Upon the completion of year 27 -	\$2.10 per hour
Upon the completion of year 30 -	\$2.17 per hour

4. **Article 35**, Compensation shall be amended in accordance with the Conciliator's Report attached as Exhibit A hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


5. Article 54 Duration and Appendix A, shall be deleted from the contract.
6. The changes set forth in this addendum are effective July 1, 2014.
7. In all other respects, the terms of the CBA are not modified.
8. This addendum shall be binding and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.


