ORDINANCE NO. 119 - 2015

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AMENDMENT/ADDENDUM WITH THE THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNITS OF THE CITY OF MACEDONIA TO BE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2016.

WHEREAS, as all of the Collective Bargaining Units of the City entered into negotiations for a wage re-opener for the year 2016 with the City pursuant to ORC 4117 and/or pursuant to their respective Collective Bargaining Agreements; and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that all the employees that comprise these Collective Bargaining Units would have their 2015 hourly rates increased by 2.75% effective January 1, 2016, that being the Patrol members of the Ohio Patrolmen Benevolent Association (OPBA), Dispatchers of the OPBA, the Command Rank members of the Fraternal Order of Police Ohio Labor Council Inc., and Firefighters and Lieutenants of Local 3947 of the International Association of Firefighters and Service Department employees of Teamsters Local 436; and

WHEREAS, in the best interests of the City and the operations of these respective Departments the Mayor and Administration urge Council to ratify the 2016 wage scale for these employees and further authorize the Mayor to execute the necessary Amendment/Addendum to the present contracts which expire on December 31, 2016 and to appropriate the necessary funds therefore.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED the Council of the City of Macedonia, Summit County, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized to enter into and execute the 2016 wage Agreement providing for a 2.75% increase in the hourly rate of all of the City's Collective Bargaining Unit employees effective January 1, 2016, that being the Patrol members of the Ohio Patrolmen Benevolent Association (OPBA), Dispatchers of the OPBA, the Command Rank members of the Fraternal Order of Police Ohio Labor Council Inc., and Firefighters and Lieutenants of Local 3947 of the International Association of Firefighters and Service Department employees of Teamsters Local 436.

Section 2. That the Finance Department is hereby authorized to make the necessary appropriation to carry out the intent of this Ordinance.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by Council and signature of the Mayor or after the earliest period allowed by law.
