MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Meigs Local School District Board of Education (hereinafter "Board") and the Meigs Local Teachers Association (hereinafter "Association") mutually agree to the following understanding with respect to the position of High School Athletic Director. The Memorandum is intended to address issues that have arisen because of the expected duties and responsibilities of the High School Athletic Director in the future.

Currently the position of Athletic Director is held by a certificated/licensed employee of the district and according to the master contract the Athletic Director is considered a bargaining unit member.

The Board and the Association, in order to accommodate the new duties and responsibilities of the Athletic Director agree to the temporary removal of the Athletic Director from the bargaining unit.

For the period of time extending from the current date until June 30, 2017 the parties agree that the position of Athletic Director will be removed from the bargaining unit. The Athletic Director position during this time will no longer be governed by the terms and conditions found in the master contract.

The ongoing nature of the position will be considered as part of a negotiation for a successor collective bargaining agreement to succeed the master contract that expires on June 30, 2017.

This Memorandum of Understanding is non-binding and non-precedent setting with respect to either party's position in the future. The Memorandum is intended to address the specific issue mentioned and no others. Each party enters into this Memorandum of Understanding voluntarily and with full knowledge of its significance. The Memorandum will expire on the date a successor collective bargaining agreement is reached in 2017.
